The Necks are a group that require high definition amplification in order to deliver the full spectrum of sonic possibilities from their instruments.

Below is a guide as to what we prefer. We can work with most PA's. Please contact us well in advance to confirm/discuss what you are able to provide.

FOH;

1st choice: D&B line array or point source, L-Acoustics Line array, Meyer Line array.

2nd choice: Martin Line array, EAW Line array or point source, Nexo alpha point source or Line array. The system must be capable of delivering 100dB(A) at the mix position with a minimum of 6dB headroom before any compression or limiting when operating at this level.

Preferred consoles;

Digital: Most digital consoles will suit. Prefer Midas Pro Series, Digidesign/Avid Profile, SC48, Yamaha CL5, DigiCo, Allen and Heath, Soundcraft.

We have show files for all of these consoles.

Analogue: Midas: H2000, H3000, XL4, XL3. Yamaha: PM3000, PM2000

Monitors;

Minimum of 3 sends required. Min 3 x wedges. Prefer D&B.

FOH console must be positioned in the auditorium, not in a separate control room.

Please allow 2 hours for setup and soundcheck.
